

Turbocharger Packing Spec

1. Box

- Ensure the box is an appropriate size, with the turbocharger taking up the majority of space within the box.
- Re-inforce the bottom with an additional sheet of strong cardboard, to ensure the turbo does not break out of the bottom.

2. Packaging material

- Make sure that impact-absorbing material is placed in all cavities of the box space, including <u>underneath</u> and on top of the turbo.
- **NOTE:** Electronic actuators are highly prone to damage in transit, and must be specially protected. Wrap them in thick bubble wrap to ensure they are not damaged.



3. Notes/addressing

- Please ensure you have a clearly marked note inside the box stating the <u>purpose</u> <u>of the turbo return</u>, eg. "Cost of Repair" or "Warranty inspection" etc., and your <u>account name</u> and <u>account code</u>.
- If you have been given an "RO" or "WA" number, write it clearly on the outside of the box.
